OPERABILITY

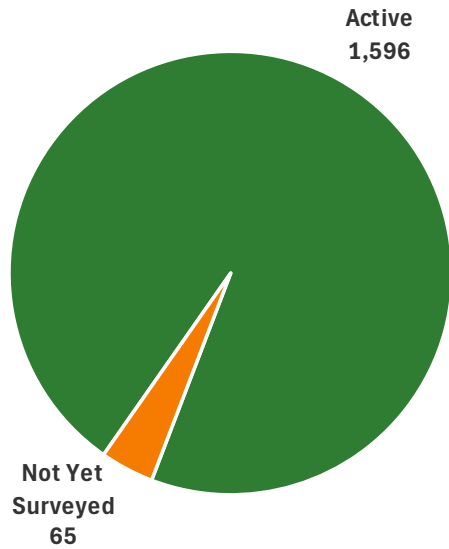
95.5% operable. 76 trailers reported as non-operable — potential candidates for surplus/disposal.

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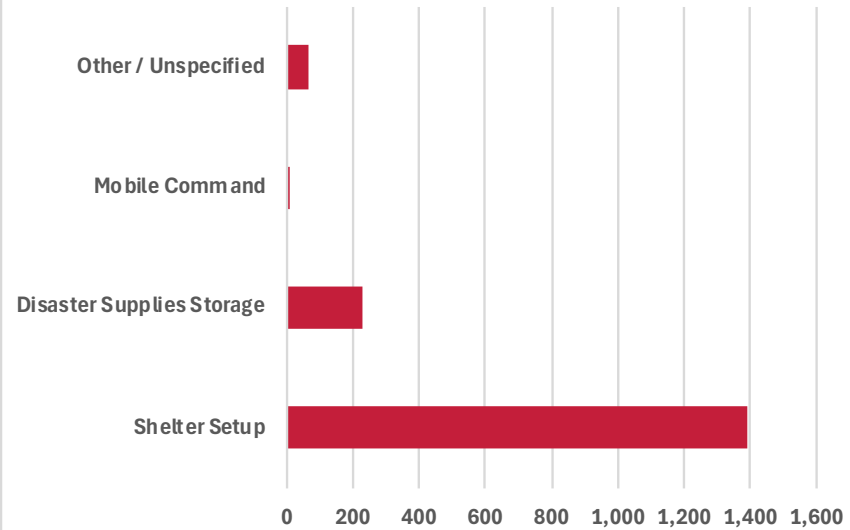

Fleet Status Distribution

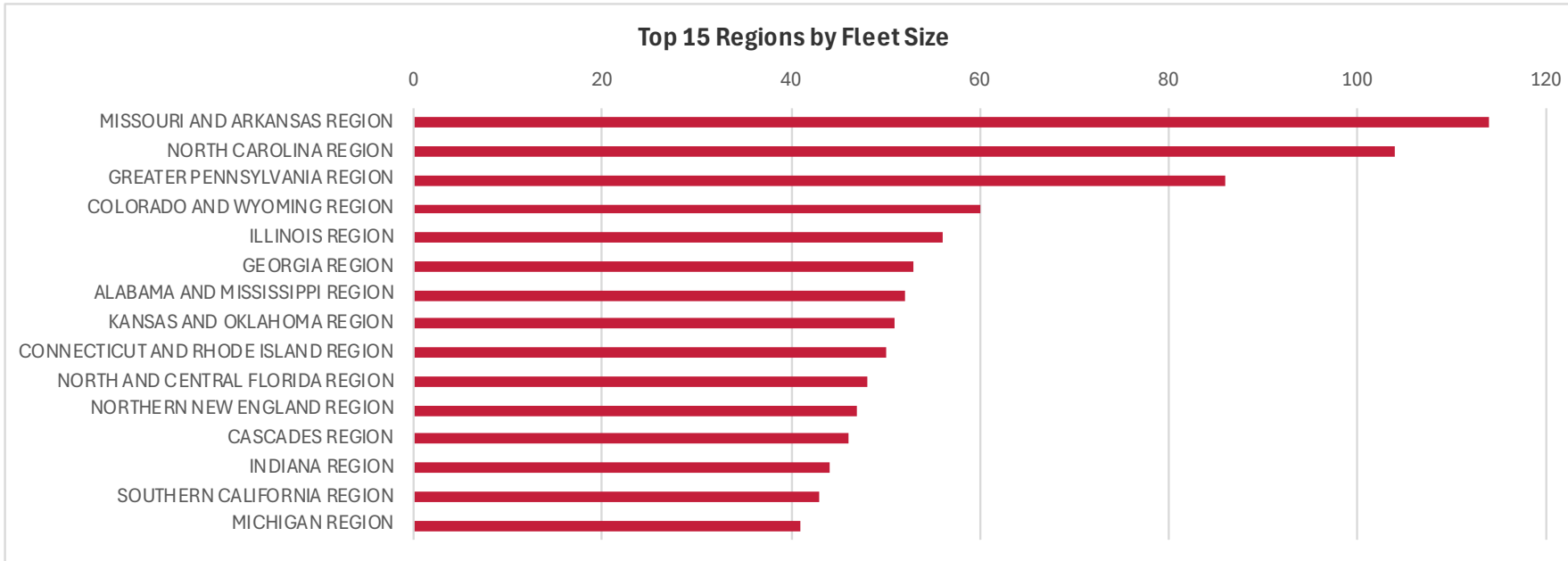


Fleet by Function
